

Dear Supplier,

Several years ago, Tower Automotive implemented the use of a productive materials inventory management and visualization tool called **I-Supply**. Our records indicate that you use this application today, as a tool for determining what product to ship and/or communicating advance ship notices, to one or more of our plants in North America.

This letter is to inform you that Tower Automotive has decided to discontinue the use of the I-Supply tool and transition our suppliers to traditional EDI releases (830) and advance ship notices (856) beginning **March 1, 2007** and no later than **May 1, 2007**. This decision has nothing to do with the functionality or reliability of the I-Supply product. Tower Automotive is working hard this year to standardize our materials management processes across all of our North America plant locations, and we have elected to get back to basics and make our releases the standard method of communicating what you need to ship to us.

In the unlikely event that you are not able to handle our EDI requirements, you will be required to subscribe to a web-based tool in order to receive our releases and send advanced shipment notifications to Tower Automotive. There is a small fee associated with using this web-based service; however, there is no charge for using traditional EDI.
